 - Intermediate Epee: Men 1:00, Women 1:00
3. BFA Cards: Membership of the British Fencing Association is a condition of entry. Bring your card with you and show it at check-in. Social members please carefully read the sentence marked near the entry form signature.
4. Novices Eligibility: Open to those with 0, 1, 2 or 3 (but not more) years aggregate fencing experience, living or fencing in Surrey (which includes London south of the river and west of Ravensbourne River). Out of area fencers may contact the organiser re. competing without being included in the results/medals.
5. Intermediates Eligibility: Not open to those who have achieved a top three placing in any county or region event (men) or have won a regional or county event (women) or top 16 placing in any national event with more than 64 entries, last 8 with 33-64 and last 4 otherwise (all) – in the weapon entered. At organisers discretion. Please send details with entry. Open to those eligible and living or fencing in Surrey, which includes London south of the river and west of Ravensbourne River. Out of area fencers may contact the organiser re. competing without being included in the results/medals.
6. Separate womens competitions will be held if sufficient numbers enter, else men's & womens events will be combined (in which case separate trophies would be awarded to the highest placed women).
7. All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see [BFA website](#)).
9. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory, per BFA rules.
10. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
11. You may enter the SCFU Intermediates as well as Novices at the same weapon at the discounted rate of only £5 extra but the organiser reserves the option to exclude from the Intermediates any Novices who are still fencing when the Intermediates starts (fee would be refunded).
12. You may enter two events but you might not be allowed to compete in both. If you are still fencing in one when the second starts then your entry fee will be refunded.
13. Please do bring you own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
14. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
