Rules re eligibility –

These championships are open to British citizens who are individual members in the appropriate grade of ENG/SF/WAFU or NIAFU who have not -

- a) already won the British Novice or Intermediate Men's or Women's Foil Championship**
- b) been in the top 100 of the men's senior rankings or the top 50 of the women's senior rankings for the relevant weapon at the end of the previous season**
- c) are over 13 years of age, calculated as for British/England age groups**

Membership cards MUST be produced at check-in. Check your affiliation now and renew as necessary. Memberships will not be issued on the day of the comp Make sure you have your card with you.

When entering it is a great help if you state your name, address, inc post code, tel no or other contact no, affil no and date of expiry. State name of competition, your club and enclose fee and sae for details. Ensure you have funds to cover cheque.

Format – The competitions will be run with 1 round of pools followed by D.E. using electric recording apparatus However, the organisers reserve the right to make any changes they see fit to ensure the smooth running of the competitions.

Please support us by arriving on time and letting us know before the date if you find yourself unable to fence, so enabling us to run the competition more efficiently.

There is no cafeteria at this venue so make sure you bring hot drinks and food but do not consume in the sportshall. Black soles are not allowed in the gym.

The organisers, Sussex County Fencing Union, its officers, Worth School, Headmaster and Governors can accept no responsibility for any loss of equipment, damage to persons or property. howsoever caused Fencers must arm, equip and clothe themselves at their own responsibility and risk.
