## Wimbledon Invitation Challenge Trophy

Wimbledon Fencing Club will be holding the annual Invitation Challenge Trophy on Sunday 7<sup>th</sup> March 2010 at Ursuline High School from 10.00am to 4.00pm.

**New format this year ! Each team will now be made up of 6 fencers  
2 Foilists, 2 Epeeists and 2 Sabreurs who can be male or female**

The competition consists of two rounds. Round one is a seeding round, the top four enter pool 1 and the lowest four enter pool 2 for the second round. In round two all fencers are awarded scores for their final position, 16 for the highest and 1 for the lowest. Each club's scores are added together for the final result. **It gives a full day's fencing for all fencers.**
