- 2. Venue: Wimbledon College, LONDON SW19 4NS <u>Link to web map</u>. Venue is booked 9am-6pm. Access from Edge Hill, via the entrance slightly uphill from the church. There is some parking in the playground near the Sports Hall.
- 3. Report By Times (these are "close of report" times):

Individual Foil 09:30

Individual Sabre 12:30 (Anyone sabreurs still fencing in the foil will be offered a refund).

Team Sabre matches will start as soon as fencers are out of the individual (not before 2:00).

- 4. Each event is likely to be mixed men/ladies, depending on entry (organisers discretion).
- 5. BFA Cards: Bring evidence of British Fencing Association membership and show it at check-in.
- 6. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
- 7. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory. Lamé (electric) mask bibs are now required (please contact organiser with any queries about this).
- 8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (www.BritishFencing.com).
- 9. Age restriction: fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event.

  The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
- 10. Blade size restrictions: Any size in the range 0 to 5 allowed.
- 11. Please do bring your own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
- 12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
