2. Venue: [Surrey University Sports Park, Arena B](#), Richard Meyjes Road, Guildford, Surrey GU27AD.

(Venue is booked 9am-4pm, ref email from JH 17<sup>th</sup> Sept2010).

"We have quite a lot going on over the weekend so parking will be extremely busy. We have created some extra spaces at the back of our building which have been allocated to your group and also England RFU. These spaces can be found by driving through our coach park, down the side of the building and then to the right of our astro pitches. If you have any difficulty finding this then please come to front of house first and ask."

3. Report by Time: 9:15am (same time for men and women to allow events to combine if one is small).
4. BFA Membership: All team members to bring evidence of your British Fencing Association membership.
5. Teams are of three fencers. You may substitute a reserve during a match if you wish provided they were nominated (record on pool sheet) before the match starts. If there is sufficient interest in a separate womens team event then that may be arranged.
6. Referee: If your club can bring a referee, this will help the smooth running of the competition.
7. Kit: You must bring your kit in good working order and in a safe condition. The organiser reserves the right to refuse to allow a fencer to compete in kit he considers to be unsafe. Plastrons are mandatory. If your mask has no lame, please try to get & fit one. [Link to suppliers](#). (Wire not required if lame makes contact).
8. All fencers must participate in accordance with BFA Safety Guidelines (see [www.BritishFencing.com](http://www.BritishFencing.com)).
9. Age restriction: All fencers must be age 13 years or over before 1st January in the season of the event. The season runs from 1st September to 31st August.
10. Blade size restrictions: Any size in the range 0 to 5 allowed.
11. Please do bring your own provisions but do not consume or spill sticky drinks in the sports hall. Your entry fee does not include cleaning of the sports hall; we are relying on no one spilling any food or drink.
12. Disclaimer: All fencers are reminded that they compete at their own risk. The organisers will take all reasonable care, but do not accept liability for loss or injury, howsoever caused. For Under 18 competitors a parent or guardian must sign the entry form. If you are under 18 and object to photography then consult the organiser.
